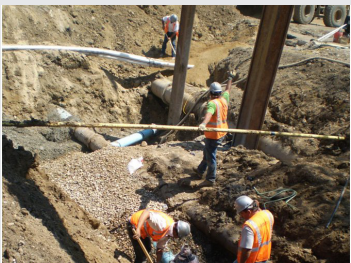

Vista West Engineering received an Award for Excellence for their Brooks/Smith Street Reconstruction Project from the American Concrete Pavement Association (ACPA) Colorado/Wyoming Chapter during their February 2009 convention held in Denver, Colorado. Also receiving award recognition was the City of Sheridan and the General Contractor – Concrete Works of Colorado. Vista West Engineering also received an honorable mention from the Wyoming Engineering Society for the project.

The project was recognized for the extensive use of concrete pavement in an urban street setting and for the overall complexity of the project, which involved working around conflicts with major communication conduits feeding the entire city while upgrading all water, sewer and storm drainage facilities in the area. Additional challenges were presented by extremely poor soil conditions and buried obstacles ranging from abandoned bridge abutments, other utility lines and headstones left over from an old monument company. In spite of the challenges, the contractor completed the project with an overrun of only one day.

Additional work involved installation of a sanitary sewer siphon under Big Goose Creek at the west end of Smith Street.
